Course Synopsis

Description: The premier problem in the fire investigation industry continues to be that multiple, well-qualified investigators can review the same fire scene evidence and arrive at dramatically different conclusions regarding origin and cause. As a first step in addressing the problem, this course is designed to teach a novel approach and methodology for logically, consistently, and accurately identifying areas of fire origin. Classroom instruction will introduce attendees to critical thinking concepts, and group exercises will enable attendees to actually apply the concepts to real world investigative problems. It should be noted that course content is not currently part of any traditional fire investigation curriculum or training program, and attendees will be exposed to a new and innovative investigative thought process.
